## Week 8-10: Conflict Resolution Posters

## Week 11: Keys to Success

-Fifth graders begin working on activities that will be a part of Viking Visit Conferences in the Spring. Viking Visits are a way for parents to connect with their child and the counselor on activities students complete over the course of their fifth grade year that can help them be more successful learners. Activities are compiled on a two sided piece of paper called a "Learner Resume." This week students complete three fun quizzes to raise awareness of very basic but essential "Keys to success": Following directions, concentrating, and focusing.
